## CALLING ALL MUSICIANS, SINGERS,ETC.

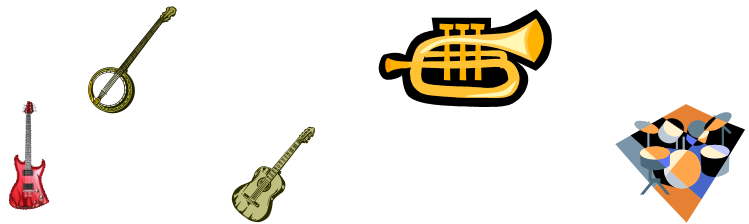
