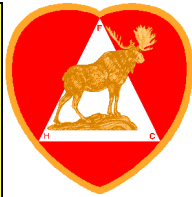

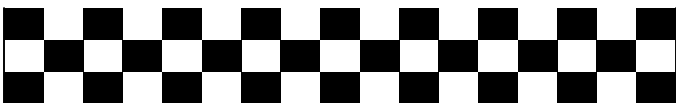

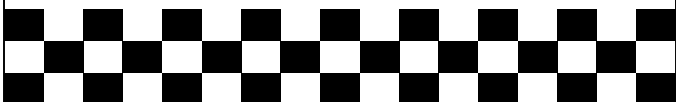


Congrats to Jon Dillingham!
