GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE

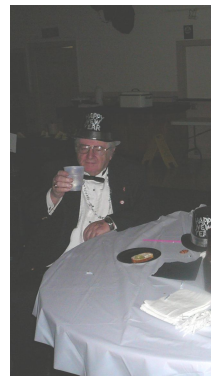
Well it looks like spring may finally be trying to make its way here. The trees are beginning to show a few small buds. I don't know about you but I sure am glad to see it.

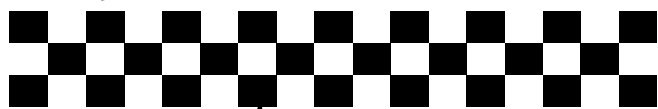

Batter Up 2011 There will be 2 fundraiser Dinners this month in which all the proceeds will go to allow us to sponsor Youth Ball Teams again this spring.

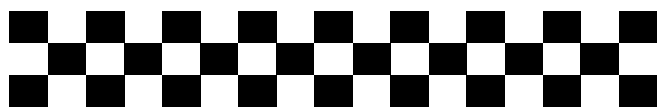
March 12th and March 26th. Look for posters in the social quarters. Help us to support our local kids and have a good meal for only \$6.00!

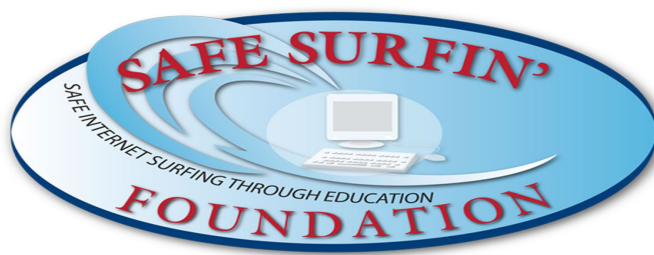
Shout out of thanks to those who have donated to our propane fund for the patio! Your continued support is appreciated. Without your help we would not be able to provide the propane.
