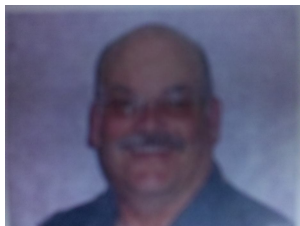

Thank you, in advance, for your support.



**Blood Drive June 1st**

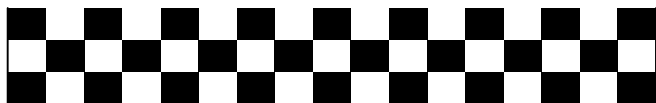
**The Blood Mobile will be here Wednesday June 1st from 5-7:30 !**

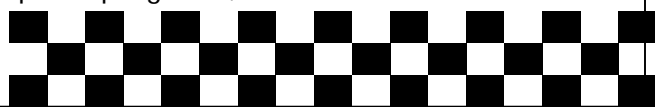
